ANNUAL/DISCOVER PASS

The Annual/Discover Pass are available to enrolled Colville Tribal members with rights in Washington State while parked or operating a motor vehicle on state-managed recreation lands, without fees, for the purpose of conducting tribal cultural activities. Provide a copy of your Colville Tribal ID card, along with current address and contact number to the NRE/Parks and Recreation office and the pass will be mailed to you. We are located at the Mt Tolman Complex, Keller, Washington and you can pick one up at our office also. The current Pass has a green trim around the border. If you should lose the pass or it becomes destroyed, we can re-issue a new one to you with just a phone call to verify address.

Washington State Boat Launch permits are also available to enrolled Colville Tribal members to use at State boat launch sites. Complete a boat launch self-registration envelope (available at State boat launch sites); write "Tribal ID" on the outside of the envelope and then write your tribal ID number. Place the envelope, with your tribal number showing, on the dash of your vehicle. This will serve as your boat launch permit at Washington State boat launch sites.

Boat launch permits for Lake Roosevelt are available at the NRE/Parks and Recreation office by providing a copy of your Tribal ID card, current address and contact number. The Lake Roosevelt boat launch permits must to be renewed annually.
